

Door bushings installation

Congratulations for purchasing our door bushings. Precisely machined from high durability plastic material these deliver great value with top quality finish. By your purchase you support future development of new, custom made performance parts to make our cars even more fun.

Contents: 2x Delrin door bushing 4x M6 bolt 4x M6 washer

Installation:

- 1) Mark the position of the top of the old bushing on the chassis with a pencil.
- 2) Remove the old bushing together with the bolts and washers.
- 3) Put in the new bushing, align the top with the mark and tighten it lightly, so it stays in place, but still could be moved up or down by hand.
- 4) Close the door slowly and open again.
- 5) Tighten the bushing down a bit more.
- 6) Close and open the door several times, check if they close smoothly and without noticeable movement up or down as they lock into the bushing.
- 7) When no further adjustment is necessary, tighten down the bolts. Reasonable amount by small hand wrench or hex key is sufficient, there is no need to use a larger wrench.
- 8) Repeat for the other side.

After correct installation the door should close easily and smoothly. It is normal they might require significantly more effort to open as the bushing is designed to securely hold the door in place. This will get better after several weeks of use. 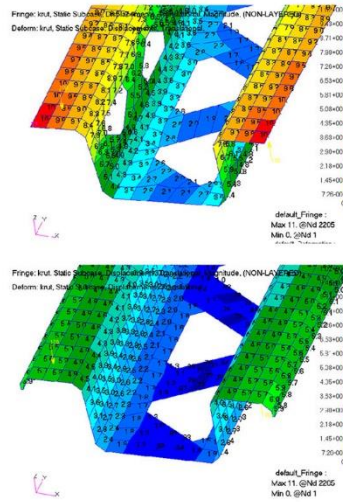
